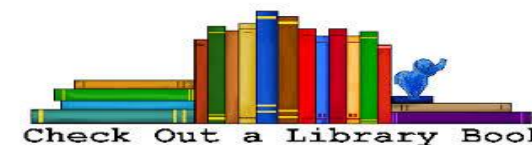
2016 tax receipts are now available.
