Augustine, 354-430 A.D. Algeria (a Roman province) in Africa.
Augustine rose to a high position in the Roman Empire as the “Voice of the Emperor” but then **had to choose whom he would serve** – the Roman **Empire** or the **Church**? In the end, he rejected fame and fortune in the Empire and became a voice for truth in the Church.

Booth, William, 1829-1912. England. William Booth, with his wife Catherine Booth, **founded the Salvation Army**, which cared for, and still cares for, people’s bodies and for their souls by providing food, shelter and support as well as a Gospel message.

Bradford, William 1590-1657 English Pilgrim befriended
North American natives. First **Thanksgiving**

Bunyan, John 1628-88 English Baptist preacher was
imprisoned for his faith: he wrote
Pilgrim’s Progress Parts 1 & 2 in 1678
and 1684 - 67 years after the King James
version of the Bible was published in 1611.

The long title of Bunyan’s book was
“Pilgrim’s Progress from this world to that
which is to come”. It was in two parts:
Part 1: Mr **Christian** Pilgrim’s journey
Part 2: his wife Mrs **Christiana** Pilgrim’s
journey: she was accompanied by their children.

Carey, William, 1761-1834 English Baptist **missionary to India**,
translated the Bible into various Indian vernacular dialects:
defender of widows

Carmichael, Amy 1867-1951 Irish **missionary to India**; founded
the Dohnavur Fellowship: protector of children: she
helped rescue young girls.

Charles, Rev Thomas 1755-1814 Welsh clergyman, inspired by the example of Mary Jones, **founded British & Foreign Bible Society** to distribute reasonably-priced Bibles to people

Damien, Father 1840-89 Belgian **missionary** to Molokai, **Hawaii, to help and comfort the outcast lepers**

Liddell, Eric 1902-45 Scottish **Olympic champion runner** refused to race on Sabbath: minister: **missionary to China**: purpose was to glorify God: died in communist prison in China

Nommensen, Ludwig, 1834-1918, Danish **missionary to Indonesia**. Translated Bible into Batak language of Sumatra. Transformed people.

Paton, John 1824-1907 Scottish **missionary to New Hebrides** in Oceania. Transformed people

Perpetua, In year 203 A.D., in Carthage, North Africa, a young Christian mother, along with her new believer companions, held firm in her faith against the Roman Empire and paid the ultimate price with her life. This is one of the most influential true stories of the Early Church. **Early church martyr.**

Raikes, Robert, 1735-1811, English philanthropist launched **Sunday School movement** to educate exploited children - to teach them to read and write in order to read the Bible.

Tubman, Harriet-1820-1913 African-American woman, Nicknamed ‘Moses’, **led hundreds of her people in escaping from slavery to freedom** in the free states or in Canada. She was the most famous **leader of the “Underground Railroad”**.

Tyndale, William 1494-1536 English Protestant reformer: **translated Bible** from the original Hebrew and Greek **into English** so that even the common people (“a **plough-boy**”) could read it: martyr

Wilberforce, William, 1759-1833, British evangelical MP
Campaigned to **abolish slave trade** and slavery in British Empire
