## **James 2:5-7**

Discrimination Dishonors God

• The contrast between God's choice and our choice (vs. 5-7)

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5:3

"For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him. For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." – Romans 10:12-13

(Deuteronomy 10:17-19, Galatians 3:28, 1 John 2:2)

• Not just a heart change, but a matter of social justice! (Isiah 1:17/Micah 6:8)

# HACK #2 Don't allow ASSUMPTION to dictate your thoughts.

#### James 2:8-13

- We are all on the same journey of faith in Christ (vs. 8-11)
- Our WORDS matter! (vs. 12)

"But I tell you that everyone will have to give account on the Day of Judgment for every empty word they have spoken. For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned." — Matthew 12:36-37

- How do I treat others who look, sound, believe, act or live differently from me? (vs. 13)
  - ☐ Discrimination Demonstrates a Lack of Mercy

# HACK #3 Treat OTHERS how you want to be treated.

- **Q4**: How do you feel about all of the discrimination happening in our world right now?
- Q5: How should Christ's judgement on the last day affect your words and actions today? How does God's grace play into this?
- **Q6**: Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Reflect on God's mercy to you in Christ. Is there anyone you need to extend that same quality of mercy to today?
- Q7: Read Isiah 1:17/Micah 6:8. What are you doing to overcome injustice?
