### James 2:14-19

• Faith without Deeds: what good is it? (vs. 14-16) • "I will pray for you..."

"If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." – 1 John 3:17-18 (Matthew 25:31-46)

- Faith without Action is Dead (vs. 17)
- Faith can only be shown by Doing (vs. 18-19)

□ <u>All for God's glory!</u> (1 Corinthians 10:23-33, Colossians 3:16-17)

- Faith without Action is Useless (vs. 20)

  Genesis 22 & Hebrews 11:17-19

• James 2:24 vs. Romans 3:28 (*Initial/Final Justification*) *"For we maintain that a person is justified by faith apart from the works of the law."* Romans 3:28

### James 2:25-26

- Faith in Action example #2: Rahab (vs. 25)
  - □ Joshua 2 & 6:22-25, Hebrews 11:31

"Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus." – Matthew 14:28-29
