5 Stages of Joseph's response in Matthew 1:18-25

- 1) **SITUATION** (vs. 1:18)
- Betrothed / Betrayal
- 2) **SEPARATION** (vs. 1:19)
- Joseph shows restraint, compassion, mercy
- 3) **SECRET** (vs. 1:20)
- NEVER Underestimate God!
- 4) **SATISFACTION** (vs. 1:21-23)
- 5) **SERVICE** (vs. 1:24-25)
- Joseph provides for Mary regardless of the cost.
