### 1) Introduction to Romans (1:1-7)

- Paul’s letter to the \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 1 & 7)
  - “The center of the known world.”
- This letter is about \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 1-7)
  - 12 indications in 7 verses! (19 times!)
- Specifically this letter is about God’s \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 2-7)
  - “Sin,” “Salvation,” “Freedom,” “Justification,” “Righteousness,” “Law,” “Faith” “LOVE”
  - Paul’s thesis = vs. 5

### 4 MAJOR Themes in Romans;

- The righteousness of God and the gospel of grace. (1:17; 3:5, 21, 22; 10:3)
- The unity of Jews and Gentiles as one family of God. (1:17; 11:11–24, 14:1–15:13)
- Christ at the center of God’s plan of salvation and the believer’s identification with Jesus in His death and resurrection. (3:21–26, 5:12–21)

- The Holy Spirit. ( 5:5; 8:2-17; 8:26–27; 14:17; 15:13)

#### DIGGING DEEPER

(For use in personal/family devotions or with your care group)

**Q1:** What was the best vacation you have had?

**Q2:** When and how did you first come in contact with the gospel?

**Q3:** We are “called to belong,” in vs. 1:6. How have you experienced that sense of belonging?

**Q4:** Read Hebrews 10:19-25. In Romans 1:12 Paul says that he hopes that he and the Romans would be “mutually encouraged by each other’s faith.” Why is this valuable to Christians in these days?

**Q5:** Read 2 Timothy 1:6-10. What do these verses reveal about the power of the gospel of Jesus?

**Q6:** Paul says in vs. 1:15-16 “I am eager...I am not ashamed of the gospel.” What can you do to express a similar enthusiasm for Christ?

**Q7:** In verse 1:8 Paul says “I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you.” Who can you thank God for? Take time to do that now.
