Q4: Have you ever purchased a product only to be disappointed with its performance or durability? If so, explain.

Q5: Have you ever been disappointed with the Lord's protection or provision in your life? If so, how did you work through that struggle?

Q6: Read John 11:1-3, 17-27. How did Martha express her frustration/disapproval to the Lord? How did Jesus respond? What did He challenge Martha to do?

Q7: Pastor David said that "miracles alone do not produce true saving faith." Do you agree/disagree with this statement? Why?

Q8: Read Jeremiah 2:9-13. How had the people of God tried unsatisfactorily to fill the hole in their soul? Why do we sometimes try to drink from cracked cisterns?
