Q5: Real Romans 16:17-20. Would Paul issue these same warnings today? Why? What else would Paul warn us about today?

Q6: Read Romans 16:25-27. What strikes you most about Paul's doxology? Q7: An exercise: Bring to mind 10 of your closest friends/coworkers/family, following Paul's example, write a short summary of what you appreciate about them the most.

Q8: Looking back at our study through Romans, what is the one truth, or most important thing that God has reminded or taught you?
