## 1) Who Is Peter? (John 1:35-42)

● Calling of Peter by Jesus – Matthew 4:18-22/Mark 1:16-20, Luke 5:1-11, John 1:35-42

## Peter was:

- Married (1 Corinthians 9:5)
- **Fisherman** by trade with his brother Andrew and their business partners James and John (Luke 5:1-11)
- A **Sinful** Man (Luke 5:8)
- Part of **Jesus Inner Circle** w/ James an John (Matthew 17:1-13, 26:36–46, Mark 5:35-43)
- Full of Faith in Jesus (Matthew 14:25-32)
- Normally the first one to speak, sometimes out of turn (Matthew 16:23)
- Rash and Hasty (Luke 22:33), Irritable and Angry (John 18:10)
- Loyal and Loving toward Jesus (Matthew 16:22)
- The Rock (Matthew 16:18)
- A **Disowner** (Luke 22:31-35, 54-62)
- The Greatest Story of Redemption Ever Recorded! (Pt #2)

## 2) What Do We Learn From Peter's Example?

• Personal	_ is SO Important!
"But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect." - 1 Peter 3:15	
O Jesus Can	_ Even the Hardest of Hearts!
"The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise, as some people think.  No, he is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to be destroyed, but wants everyone to repent." – 2 Peter 3:9	
• When We Aret	o Jesus, the Devil is Working Hard!
"Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith. Remember that your family of believers all over the world is going through the same kind of suffering you are." – 1 Peter 5:8-9
