#### 1) Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_ (13:18-21a)

*“Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me.” - John 14:1 (Matthew 26:38, John 12:27)*

#### 2) Jesus reveals His \_\_\_\_\_ (13:21b-25)

*“Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.” – 1 Peter 3:9 (Psalm 41:9, 55, Romans 12:14-20)*

#### 3) Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ the bread (13:26-27a)

*“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.” – John 10:10 (John 8:44)*

#### 4) Jesus settles His \_\_\_\_\_ (13:27b-30)

*“And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.” – Romans 8:28*

*“Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” – John 8:12 (1:4-5, 12:35)*

### DIGGING DEEPER

(For use in personal/family devotions or with your care group)

**Q1:** Have you ever been betrayed by someone? What happened?

**Q2:** One of the marks of someone who betrays Jesus is that they treat Jesus as a servant rather than bowing to Him. How might we do this?

**Q3:** How does John 13:18-30 demonstrate Jesus' power over Satan?

**Q4:** Read Psalm 118:22-24. How does this passage relate to the idea that Jesus settled His own destiny, not Judas?

**Q5:** Read Genesis 50:15-21. Can you trace God's hand at work through your past to see how He has taken evil deeds, and even evil people, and used these for good?
